

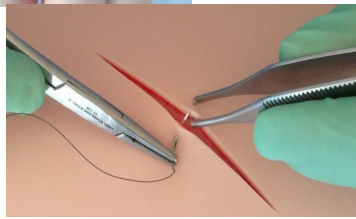
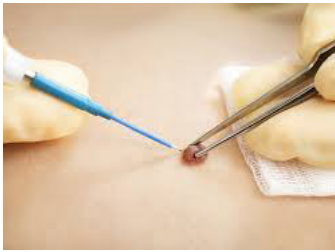

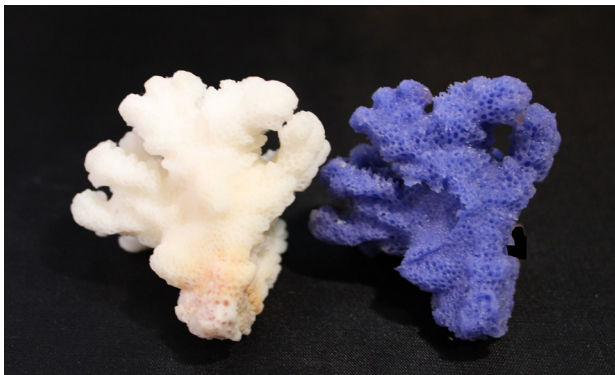
Medical Education day

These activities are perfect for campers or students who are interested in medicine. Children can make a fake wound and learn to dress it, practice suturing like a surgeon, and even remove a mole from lifelike skin.



Make a replica of an underwater plant

Students learn about underwater habitats, ecosystems, and plant life while creating an Anemone, Sea Sponge, or Finger Coral. Discuss the mold making process as well as buoyancy while making a copy of an object. Rocks and seashells don't float, but the foam versions we create do!



Copy your hand or foot

Children create an extremely detailed copy of their own hand or foot. As they do the workshop they learn about the life casting and mold making process used in Hollywood and the medical field. They mix a two-part material together to create the mold, performing a chemical reaction that requires a catalyst. Available in different materials and all colors, this workshop is a favorite.
